Our Founder Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati

Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati was a spiritual teacher, profound thinker, philosopher, lucid speaker and master of Vedanta. As a world renowed spiritual leader, his influence on the world stage has been enormous. Posthumously awarded the Padma Bhushan, Swamiji was the founder of AIM for Seva, Swami Dayananda Educational Trust, Arsha Vidya Research & Publication Trust and Arsha Vidya Gurukulams in India and USA.

Though deeply rooted in the richness of tradition Pujya Swamiji was contemporary in his thinking and approach to the issues of the day. Swamiji's impeccable logic, brilliant analysis, erudition, precise use of the language, and humour made him the greatest teacher of Advaita Vedanta. His discourses taught the most profound truths in such simple language leaving the audience spellbound. Swami Dayananda Saraswati did not confine himself just to Vedanta. His humanness and empathy extended to all civilizations, and all cultural forms. He strove to preserve, nurture and appreciate the diversity of human culture. There is no place for aggression or domination or conversion in his all embracing approach.

Around the year 2000, the local residents of Manjakkudi requested Swamiji to start a college, as the girls is their families were losing out on higher education. They were unwilling to send the girls to distant colleges as they feared for their safety while travelling in local buses. Hence, most girls stopped their education with school and went on to get married at an early age. To fulfil this need, Swami Dayananda Arts and Science College, affiliated to Bharathidasan University was started in 2001 in the village itself, as a co-educational insitution. Initially, the college operated out of a government-aided school campus, but by 2004, a brand new state-of-the-art campus was built and inaugurated by Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati.

Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati believed that sudents should graduate from an institution equipped with not just academic knowledge, but must also be well grounded cultural values. Hence, the college strives to provide the necessary training in keeping with his vision. The college encourages the students to be aware of the current events, innovations and thought processes. BHARATHIDASAN UNIVERSITY ADOPTED UGC REGULATION ON COURSE COMPLETION

(Ref. No. CCCD/BOIS/C2/2018, dt 11.04.2018)

- 1. A student who for whatever reasons is not able to complete the programme within the normal period or the minimum duration prescribed for the programme, may be allowed two years period beyond the normal period to clear the backlog to be qualified for the degree. The general formula, therefore should be as follows:
 - (a) Time Span = N+2 years for the completion of programme where N stands of the normal or minimum duration prescribed for completion of the programme.

- (b) In exceptional circumstance a further extension of one more year may be granted. The exceptional circumstances be spelt out clearly by the relevant statutory body concerned of the university.
- (c) During the extended period the student shall be considered as a private candidate and also not be eligible for ranking.
- 2. Ordinarily, no student should be given time beyond the extended period of two years. However, in exceptional circumstances and on the basis of the merits of each case university may allow a student one more year for completion of the programme.

Scholarships at Swami Dayananda College of Arts & Science

Inaugurated on Vijayadasami Day, October 2013, the Swami Dayananda Scholar Program (SDSP) is designed to encourage undergraduate students to excel in their chosen field of study. The program provides students with enhanced academic and cultural opportunities, unique to their primarily agrarian socio-economic background. It is the sincere hope of the SDSP administration that the opportunities and facilities offered will encourage the development of the student both in academics as well as in their personal sphere, and bring honour to the college and our founder Pujya Swami Dayananda Saraswati.

The program administration nurtures its scholars through graduation and beyond, expanding their intellect, guiding them academically, encouraging them to experiment with education opportunities, advising them on future prospects and Career options. The program also seeks to enrich its scholars by fostering integrity, leadership skills, a sense of civic – minded responsibility and academic excellence. To achieve these goals, the administration invites guest speakers, urges the students to take up additional project work and participate in seminars. The SDSP provides an atmosphere of continuous learning in which the students can discover their strengths and contribute to the growth of the rural community, the community of scholars, and the country.

The SDSP is a five semester program. In each semester, a maximum of twenty students may be selected for the program.

Eligibility

• Excellent academic record with an average of 80% in science courses & 75% in Arts & Commerce courses in each semester.

- Good written and communication skills.
- High standard of personal and professional conduct to meet with the college norms on and off campus.
- Initiative and leadership qualities.
- Short term and long term goals beyond their immediate personal growth. Scholars must maintain / improve their aggregate score in each semester to continue in the program.

Benefits of the SDSP

- Waiver of tuition fee 50% for aggregate scores 80% and above in each semester for science courses; 50% for aggregate scores of 75% and above in each semester for Arts & Commerce courses.
- Preferential access to library, computer lab and net facilities of the college.
- Provision to respective faculty members to avail guidance after college hours, on all days except national holidays.
- The program administration encourages students to pursue their post graduation either in Swami Dayananda College of Arts & Science or other reputed academic institutions within India by offering scholarships. They include:
- - 100% of the tuition fee for the First and Second University rank holders
- - 75% of the tuition fee for the Third to Fifth University rank holders.

Scholarship Norms

- The scholarship amount will be paid each quarter.
- The Head of the institution where the student is enrolled for post graduation must send a report to the Secretary of the Swami Dayananda College of Arts & Science.

The report must assess the student on

- Attendance
- Academic performance
- Attitude, ethical conduct and behavior Initiative and leadership
- Seminar participation and details of papers presented

The student must fulfill the above norms to continue to avail of the scholarship.

Rules & Regulations

Identity Card

Identity Cards will be issued after admission. Students should wear their Identity cards on all days within the college campus.

Use of Mobile Phones

Carrying and using of mobile phone is strictly prohibited.

Attendance

- Students must ensure a minimum of 75% attendance for each semester. Absence without prior leave sanction will be treated as indiscipline.
- Students, who are irregular in attending classes, will not be permitted to continue the course. They will not be permitted to appear for the ensuing University Examinations.
- If eligible, absence may be condoned as per Bharathidasan University rules and regulations.
- To apply for scholarship, students must have 75% of attendance and pass in all the subjects they have chosen to study.

Admission Procedure

- The cost of an application form, including the registration fee. is Rs. 100/- for U.G. and Diploma courses and Rs. 150/- for P.G. courses.
- Students who wish to receive the application form by post should send a self addressed envelope affixed with Rs. 10/- for postage and a D.D. for Rs. 100/-(UG) and Rs. 150/- (PG) in favour of 'Swami Dayananda College of Arts & Science' drawn on any nationalized bank payable at Kodavasal, Tiruvarur District.
- Please send in the application forms, duly filled in, to the Principal within 15 days of the publication of the +2 examination results.
- Applications received thereafter will be marked as late and may be considered only if there are vacancies in the course.

Please do not send the original certificate along with the application form. The college shall not be held responsible for any loss of certificate.

Candidates who are provisionally selected will be called for an interview by letter. *Candidates are required to bring the following in original when called for the interview:
